BRIEF RESUME

Since 1 June 2008, Giovanni Sabatini has been a joint manager of CONSOB (the Italian Stock Exchange Authority) and the Head of its Issuer Department. From September 2004 to May 2006, he was the Head of the Intermediary Department of CONSOB, at its Milan office; previously, he was the Head of its Market Organization Office.

From June 2006 to June 2008, he was the Head of the Banking and Financial System - Legal Advice Department of the Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance. From 2001 to 2004, he was the General Manager and CEO of Monte Titoli S.p.A.

He has extensive international experience; on behalf of CONSOB, he was the Chairman of the Working Group on the Regulation of Secondary Markets of IOSCO¹, he was Co-Chairman of the Task Force set up by IOSCO and CPSS² and he was a member of the Task Force of the Financial Stability Forum on the Regulation of Hedge Funds. From 2006 to 2008, he was also the representative from the Italian Ministry of Economy and Finance at the European Commission's Financial Services Committee and European Securities Committee.

Giovanni Sabatini was born in Rome on 22 December 1959, he graduated from LUISS University in Rome with a degree in Economics and is a chartered accountant.
